1. Purpose

The purpose of this document is to describe advising to students at Gulf University. It details principles to accomplish fair, transparent, and robust advising activities across all Colleges, Departments, and programs.

4. Definitions

Academic Advisor: The academic advisor is a faculty member at Gulf University, who is responsible for guiding the students according to University Guidelines and Regulations.

Instructor: An instructor is an individual appointed by Gulf University to teach on its courses.

Student: A student is an individual who has completed the formal procedures necessary to register in a program offered by Gulf University.

5. Policy Statement

Gulf University ensures systematic review and full compliance of its academic advising criteria with the Higher Education Council's regulations. Academic advising policy aims to supervise and monitor student guidance along with their path till they are awarded the degree.

6. Policy Details

The policy involves the following activities:

6.1 GU ensures that all students are assigned to an academic advisor with whom they will be in direct contact throughout their studies.

- 6.2 GU ensures that academic advisors support students in registration, assist in planning to meet degree requirements and selecting courses, monitor academic progress, clarify academic opportunities, look after their wellbeing, and answer any queries regarding policies and procedures.
- 6.3 GU recognizes students are ultimately responsible for the decisions they make, and the role of academic advisor is to provide guidance and support.
- 6.4 GU ensures that academic advisors are appropriately assigned for each offered program.
- 6.5 GU commits academic advisors to communicate with the students about their career and learning progression regularly.
- 6.6 GU ensures that academic advisors maintain file for each assigned student.
- 6.7 GU ensures that academic advisors meet with their assigned students and assist them with relevant guidance.
- 6.8 GU ensures that academic advisors follow the University Academic Regulations in course enrollment every semester.
- 6.9 GU ensures that Academic advisors follow-up with both regular students and those with decreasing CGPA and guide them to overcome the difficulties.
